Kalinga Kusum internships give you an opportunity to:

1. Choose your stream of work based on your skills and interests.
2. Explore and contribute towards the important aspects of running the organization.

4. Be a part of activities ranging from public mobilization, research, field exposures and documentation to piloting project ideas, learning the ropes of Human Resources, organizing events or even putting into action your media advocacy skills.

Eligibility:

Law students (3 years or 5 years course), Engineering or MBA or Social Work students may apply for full time trainee/internship positions for a period ranging from a minimum of 1 (one) month – 6 (six) months. Priority consideration will be given to applicants who have exhibited an interest in access to justice areas, legal awareness and legal aid issues, social and legal issues, and an eagerness to interact, learn and teach, for example by their voluntary work or activism on relevant causes.

What you can expect from this internship:

- Hands-on experience in the field of legal rights and access to justice.
- An opportunity to work at the grassroots level and make a difference to the community. In many cases, interns live in the communities they intern in, thus get a full immersion into the experience
- Hands on teaching, working to develop educational material or manuals, documentation or database development, conducting surveys
- An opportunity to blog and share your experience with the community at large through public media/ magazines/ news articles- local, national or international.
